Curbside Recycling Service

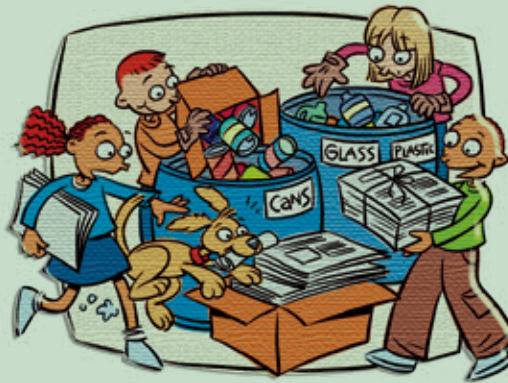


Recycling at home is easy! Southern Oregon Sanitation, Inc. offers a curbside service for residents within our recycling routes.

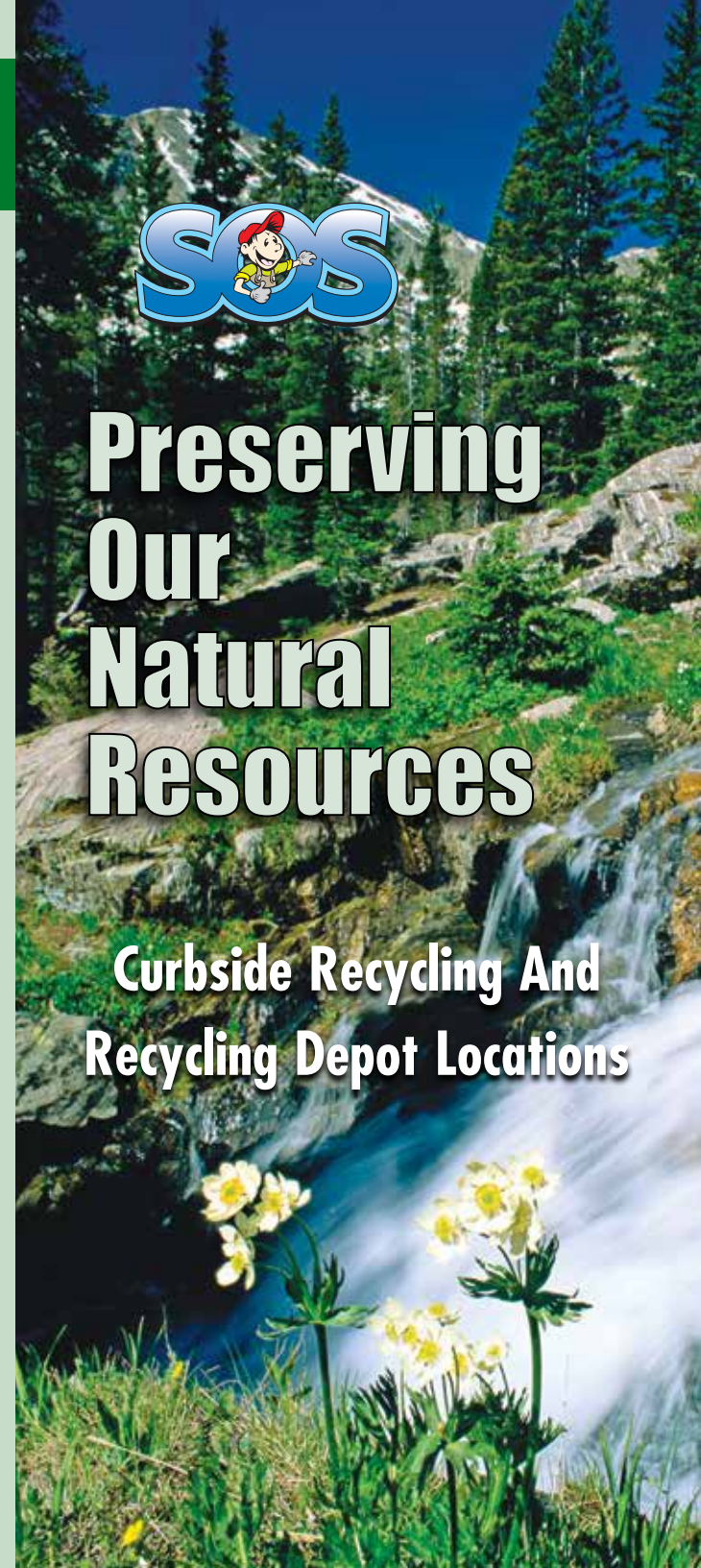

Materials Accepted:



- Cardboard, cereal boxes, tissue roll ends.
- Magazines, newspapers, scrap paper, phone books, paperback books.



- Plastic bottles and containers that carry the recycle triangle emblem up to 1 gal size.
For example: Water bottles, milk jugs, laundry detergent bottles, butter tubs, cottage cheese containers. To help the recycling process, please clean and rinse thoroughly and remove all lids on plastics.



- Tin cans, aluminum pie plates, aluminum foil. Please clean and rinse out cans.

- Glass bottles and containers.



- Used motor oil. Pour into 1 gallon plastic containers with screw lids.



NOTE: Empty motor oil or anti-freeze containers will not be accepted.

Other Recycling Depots

* Please note: To help the recycling process please rinse out food items, remove lids from plastics and do not recycle hazardous waste.



* Please note: some restrictions apply at certain locations as to the materials accepted. Call specific locations for detailed information.

Materials Accepted

Newspapers, magazines, catalogs, tin cans, cardboard (no wax coated), paper bags, plastic **bottles/containers** up to 1 gallon size, glass **bottles/containers**, motor oil (pour into 1 gal. containers with screw cap lids), electronics, rechargeable batteries/cell phones, scrap metal (up to 1 yd), appliances (fee), wood & yard waste (fee).

Newspapers, magazines, catalogs, tin cans, cardboard (no wax coated), paper bags, office paper, electronics, recyclable plastics.

Cars, lawn mowers, hot water heaters, washers, dryers, air conditioners, freezers, refrigerators, \$10.00 charge for removal of compressors from appliances, car batteries, metals, aluminum, clean tin cans.

Wood waste, yard waste, leaves, grass clippings, small branches.

Yard debris, grass clippings, leaves, pruning's, brush, trees (6' max. length), and horse manure.
